

KANSAI PLASCON ANTI-MOSQUITO PAINT

1. Is Kansai Plascon Anti-Mosquito Paint a repellent?

No, it is not a repellent. It is a “knock-down” paint.

2. What does knock-down mean?

The mosquitoes that land on surfaces painted with Plascon Anti-Mosquito paint lose their ability to move and fall off the surface.

3. How long is Anti-Mosquito paint effective once applied?

Scientifically Plascon Anti-Mosquito paint has been proven to be effective for two years provided the mosquitoes land on the painted surface.

4. Will Anti-Mosquito paint repel mosquitoes?

Plascon Anti-Mosquito paint has knock-down properties not repellent properties

5. Is Anti-Mosquito paint available in different colours?

Yes. At present it is available in pastel base colours (807 colours) and white, and we intend to extend the range.

6. When will Anti-Mosquito paint be available in stores?

October 1st, 2018. This product is currently only available for sale in Zambia.

7. Can Anti-Mosquito paint be diluted with water?

Please refer to the Technical Data Sheet.

8. Price range?

Kansai Plascon Anti-Mosquito paint is priced as a mid-range product.

9. What surfaces can Anti-Mosquito paint be painted on?

Please refer to the Technical Data Sheet.

10. How long does it take for the mosquito to be knocked down?

After exposure to surfaces painted with Anti-Mosquito paint, the mosquito should be knocked down within approximately 24 - 48 hours.

11. Is Anti-Mosquito paint harmful to health/ humans?

It has been certified by the National Health Research Authority (NHRA) that once dry, the paint has no harmful effects on health or humans (including children).

12. Does the mosquito die instantly and completely?

The mosquito that makes contact with surfaces painted with Plascon Anti-Mosquito paint will (90%) be knocked down and eventually die.

13. Can Anti-Mosquito paint be painted on an exterior surface?

Plascon Anti-Mosquito paint is an interior paint and cannot be used on exterior surfaces.

14. If I use Anti-Mosquito paint, will I still need to use an insecticide / repellent?

Prevention has no limitation. Plascon Anti Mosquito Paint is compatible to commonly used insecticides.

15. Is Anti-Mosquito paint washable and how many times can it be washed?

Yes, Kansai Plascon Anti-Mosquito paint is washable with a soft cloth and mild soap solution. Surfaces painted with Anti-Mosquito paint should not be scrubbed.

16. **If walls painted with Anti-Mosquito paint are wiped, will it still be effective? If yes, does it reduce the effectiveness, and to what extent?**
Yes, surfaces painted with Kansai Plascon Anti-Mosquito paint can be wiped as directed on the product label. Provided you follow instruction on the *Technical Data Sheet*, the effectiveness should not decrease.
17. **Can I paint Anti-Mosquito Paint over an existing paint?**
Yes. However, please refer to surface preparation instructions for Anti-Mosquito paint available on the *Technical Data Sheet*.
18. **If Anti-Mosquito paint is painted in one room of a structure, will it be effective in the rest of the areas within the structure?**
Anti-Mosquito paint is known to be effective in rooms painted with such paint. To obtain optimal results, it is strongly suggested that all rooms be painted with Anti-Mosquito paint.
19. **If walls are painted with Anti-Mosquito paint, what will happen to areas of gloss? Will it still work e.g. doors and walls painted in gloss finish?**
Kansai Plascon Anti-Mosquito paint is presently not available in gloss finish; it is available in a smooth matt finish.
20. **Can Anti-Mosquito paint be effective in thatched roof houses?**
Yes, provided the walls are surfaces that can be painted with Plascon Anti-Mosquito paint as specified in the *Technical Data Sheet*.
21. **Does Anti-Mosquito paint kill flies or other insects like bees?**
This is an ANTI-MOSQUITO PAINT.
22. **How long should it take for people to access the place after painting Anti-Mosquito paint in the house?**
Anti-Mosquito paint usually takes approximately two hours to dry. It is safest to access the room once the walls are completely dry. (This is dependent on atmospheric conditions). During painting, always ensure you are using appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Please refer to package label and *Safety Data Sheet*.
23. **How long is Anti-Mosquito paint effective for?**
Scientifically, Plascon Anti-Mosquito Paint remains effective for a period of two years.
24. **Can Anti-Mosquito paint buckets be reused for other purposes?**
Anti-Mosquito paint contains a pesticide and the container should not be reused for any other purpose. Please follow disposal instructions on the label and *Safety Data Sheet*.
